

**NOTICE OF DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS
NORTH BRANCH ECORSE CREEK DRAIN**

NOTICE IS FURTHER HEREBY GIVEN, that on the 31st day of July, 2006, at 3501 Henry Ruff, Westland, Michigan 48170, or at such other time and place thereafter, to which I, the County Drain Commissioner of the County of Wayne, may adjourn the same, the apportionment for benefits for Maintenance and the apportionment for benefits for the Flood Control Study and the lands comprised within the "North Branch Ecorse Creek Drain Special Assessment District," and the apportionments thereof will be subject to review for one day, from 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon. Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the meeting should contact Andrew Keller at (734) 326-4500 at least one week in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Michigan Drain Code, any owner of land within the drainage district or any city, village, township, district or county feeling aggrieved by the apportionment of benefits made by the Wayne County Drain Commissioner, may appeal the apportionment within ten (10) days after the day of review of apportionment by making an application to the Wayne County Probate Court for the apportionment of a board of review.

The following is a condensed description of the lands constituting the Special Assessment District of said Drain:

The description of area that is served by the North Branch Ecorse Creek Drain consists of lands situated in the cities of Allen Park, Dearborn Heights, Ecorse, Inkster, Lincoln Park, Melvindale, Romulus, Taylor and Westland, Wayne County, Michigan.

- In Allen Park – An area bounded by Outer Drive on the North, Southfield Freeway and Van Born Road on the Northwest, Pelham Road on the West, Midway Avenue on the South, I-75 on the Southeast and Dix Highway to the East. Inclusive of lands in Sections 2, 11 and 14.
- In Dearborn Heights – An area bounded by Dartmouth Street on the North, Inkster Road on the West, Van Born Road on the South, Southfield Freeway to the Southeast and Outer Drive on the Northeast. Inclusive of lands in Sections 31-35.
- In Ecorse – An area bounded by Visger Road on the North, South Bassett Street on the Northwest, Ecorse Creek on the West, Emmons Boulevard on the South and High Street on the East.
- In Inkster – An area bounded by Michigan Avenue to the North, Henry Ruff to the West, Annapolis Avenue on the South, and Sylvia Avenue to the East.
An area bounded by Lehigh Avenue to the North, Sylvia Avenue to the West, Annapolis to the South and Beach Daly to the East. Inclusive of lands in Sections 25, 31, 35 and 36.
- In Lincoln Park – An area bounded by Outer Drive on the North, Dix Highway on the West, Emmons Boulevard on the South and the Ecorse Creek on the East.
- In Melvindale – An area bounded by Schaefer Highway on the North, Railto Street on the West, Outer Drive on the South and Fisher Freeway on the East. An area bounded by Roycroft Street on the North, Henry Street on the West, Outer Drive on the South and Gale Boulevard on the East.
- In Romulus – An area bounded by Van Born on the North, Chesapeake & Ohio Railroad on the West, Wick Road on the South and Inkster on the East. Inclusive of lands in Sections 1-5 and 8-13.

In Taylor – An area bounded by Van Born Road to the North, Inkster Road on the West, Goddard Road on the South and Pelham Road on the East. Inclusive of lands in Sections 3-10 & 15-18.

In Westland – An area bounded by Michigan Avenue on the North, Merriman Road on the West, Van Born Road on the South and Inkster Road on the East. Inclusive of lands in Sections 35 and 36.
